The District will continue to offer meal pick for five (5) breakfast and five (5) lunch meals on this Monday, April 20, 2020, from 8:30 AM to 12:00 noon and then again from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. The person picking up the food is required to know the student's full name as well school identification number. Students do not need to present to pick up their meals for the week.

Out-of-District and Choice students can pick up their meals from local community sites.
