Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

The Senior Class of 2019 has been given permission to go to Disney World for their Senior Trip. The trip is scheduled for Monday, April 8 through Friday, April 12, 2019. The cost of the trip is \$1440. This includes airfare, room, meal debit cards, busing, and admission to the parks. Students will need extra money should they wish to buy extra food, snacks and souvenirs. Students can make their initial deposit of \$480 beginning **April 30th**. Deposits should be brought to my office before June 18<sup>th</sup>, the last day of school. After June 18<sup>th</sup> and throughout the summer, students may submit their deposit to Mrs. Sue Clune in the general office. The initial deposit will reserve a spot on the trip for your son or daughter. The second payment (\$480) will be due in September/October and the final payment (\$480) will be due in November.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Late fees are to ensure payments are received on time so that the travel agency can be paid its installments on time.

**The final day that a senior can sign up for the trip is Friday, September 21st. After this date the travel agency cannot assure a seat on the plane.**

Participating seniors will need a **PHOTO ID** to get on the plane. The only forms of ID currently accepted by the airlines are: **A VALID NEW JERSEY DRIVER'S LICENSE, VALID NEW JERSEY PHOTO ID OR A PASSPORT**. A copy of the photo ID must be submitted along with the final payment.
